

All Star Studios Recital Packet 2019

When:	Sunday, June 2nd, 2019 (1st show: 10am, 2nd Show: 12:30pm, 3rd Show: 4pm) <i>Your dancer's show time has been listed with their class on the fall schedule since last June. Refer to that schedule to figure out which show(s) your child will be performing in.</i>
Where:	York College Performing Arts Center: Main Stage Theater 94-45 Guy R. Brewer Boulevard, Jamaica, NY 11451 <i>The theater has a free parking lot and public transportation is very accessible.</i>
Costume pick-up day:	Thursday, May 9th from 3:30pm-9pm. All costumes that have been delivered will be distributed during their regular classes. Pick up is only for costumes that haven't arrived yet or if you missed your regular class. Descriptions from your teacher explaining hair, tights, and any other special instructions regarding their costume will be posted on the 4 th floor of the studio and the website. The costumes are not for everyday wear. If they get lost or damaged they cannot be replaced. <i>If you have a balance in your portal, you will not receive your costume until the balance is taken care of. No exceptions.</i>
Ordering Pictures:	Viewing and purchase of pictures will be in the lobby of York College at the mandatory Dress Rehearsal Thursday, May 23rd, 2019. No obligation to buy the pictures. Picture day details are listed on our website: www.allstarstudiosnyc.com
Mandatory Dress Rehearsal:	Thursday, May 23rd at York College Performing Arts Center [94-45 Guy R Brewer Blvd, Jamaica, NY 11451] <i>Schedule will be emailed at the end of this week.</i> This is MANDATORY and if your dancer does not attend, they WILL NOT be in the recital. If you have a last minute sickness or emergency please <u>email</u> the studio so we receive it...do not call the studio because we will be at the theater. The time listed is when your dancer needs to be at the theater. Plan to be there for at least 60-90 min. Dressed in their FULL COSTUMES! Students with multiple classes should wear tights and plain black leotards so they can pull their different costumes on and off quickly. Parents can stay and watch in the audience. No parents allowed backstage unless you signed up to volunteer ahead of time. Email us if you are interested in being a class parent. You may leave as soon as your child is done dancing.
DADDY DANCE!!!!!! Sign up starting: May 1st and MUST be signed up before May 15th!!	Space is limited so you have to sign up in person, have a family member do it for you, or call during class hours. NO EMAILS OR VOICEMAILS PLEASE!! This helps avoid overcrowding. Sign-ups start May 1st and MUST be signed up before May 15th. Make sure you know which show(s) your dancer is in and you must let us know at the time of signing up which rehearsals you will be attending. <u>Rehearsals WITHOUT your dancers will be:</u> <i>**You must attend a minimum of 2 days before the mandatory one on Saturday, June 1st.</i> -Fri, May 17 th 7-8pm (3rd floor) -Sun, May 19 th 2:30-4:30pm (4th floor) -Mon, May 20 th 7:30-8:30pm (4th floor) -Fri, May 31 st 7-8pm (3rd floor) <u>A mandatory rehearsal WITH your dancer(s) Saturday, June 1st:</u> <u>10am show Daddies: 5:00-5:45pm (4th floor)</u> <u>12:30pm Show Daddies: 5:45-6:30 (4th floor)</u> <u>4pm Show Daddies: 6:30-7:15pm (3rd floor)</u> <i>**Attendance will be taken and you cannot perform (and will not receive your recital t-shirt) if you haven't been to the minimum rehearsals.</i>
Recital Tickets:	Tickets go on sale May 18 th at noon, seats are assigned (\$15-\$25) and it's first come first serve...like buying concert tickets. <i>Lost tickets will not be refunded. There are no promo codes.</i> Please READ CAREFULLY and click to purchase the correct show. Tickets bought during separate transactions are not guaranteed to be together. Volunteers:	Sign up to volunteer the day of the recital and rehearsal by responding to this email with the show time that you would like to help out with. There will be a mandatory volunteer meeting Monday, May 20th from 7- 8pm. You must also be available at Dress Rehearsal so you know what to do on recital day and to help out with your specific class. You will be able to see your child perform during the show. We cannot make the recital possible without the help of all of you! This year we are asking for TWO parent volunteers from each class for ages 6 and under. Please email us with which show (10am, 12:30pm, or 4pm) and class your child is in if you are interested! <i>If your child requires the use of an EPI pen for their allergies, you MUST volunteer.</i>
Program Dedications:	Email your dedication and picture to allstarstudiosnyc@gmail.com Pictures must be in Jpeg form. DEADLINE MAY 13TH. NO EXCEPTIONS. <i>Your card on file will be charged once you submit your request. \$30 per quarter page/\$60 half-page/\$100 for a full page.</i>
Flowers and Bears:	Pre-order flowers for your dancer. Pick them up in the lobby at the recital! This is the link to the website https://www.thecommcementgroup.com/allstarstudios/
Dancers on Recital day:	ALL DANCERS NEED TO BE BACKSTAGE or IN THE BALCONY AT LEAST 30 MINUTES BEFORE SHOWTIME DRESSED, FED, HAVING GONE TO THE BATHROOM AND READY TO DANCE!!! Please label all of your child's items. Snack, water, shoes (on the inside). WE ARE PEANUT FREE. The show order, check in-times, and specific details about checking in and checking out your child will be emailed May 24th. This will also inform you on where to check your child in (Balcony vs. Greenroom). There is no coming to give your dancer food, fixing their hair/makeup, or just coming to say 'Hi' during the show. We promise they are in good hands! Students age 5 and above are expected to stay for the whole show and to perform in the finale. Special requests need to be approved a week before the recital and forms filled out.
Backstage:	Only dancers and volunteers are allowed backstage. This will cut down on confusion and help the students to remain focused. You will be able to pick up your dancer from the greenroom after they perform the finale. Parents of 3 year olds can pick up their child after their individual performance, but will need to purchase them a ticket if they want to bring them to the audience to watch. This year we are asking for TWO parent volunteers from each class for ages 6 and under. Please email us with which show you are in (10am, 12:30pm, or 4pm) and which class your child is in if you are interested! There will be a mandatory volunteer meeting Monday, May 20th from 7- 8pm. You will be able to see your child perform during the show. It is ideal if you can volunteer during your class time for rehearsal as well. That will be a much shorter time commitment.
Show Length:	The 10am show will be under an hour and the afternoon shows will be about 2-2.5 hours each. Please be respectful of the rest of the audience and the performers by using professional theater etiquette. Again, Students age 5 and above are expected to stay for the whole show and to perform in the finale. We will not be releasing students 5 and up without previous permission at any point during the show. <i>Trophies will be handed out in your child's regular dance class the week after the recital. We will have regular classes the week following the recital.</i>
Photographs/ Video:	Video and flash photography are prohibited. This includes handheld devices. Cell phones and tablets become an overwhelming distraction to fellow audience members and the performers. <i>A video link of your dancer's performance is included in your recital fee. If you would like a physical DVD, they can be purchased at: www.ACutAboveLa.com. You may videotape and take pictures during rehearsal.</i>
